Update on Community Dinners
Wellington Square United Church
Fridays at 6:00 P.M.

This community outreach project is in full swing at Wellington Square United. It is made possible by the leadership of Wellington Square and also by the growing partnership and assistance from Burlington Baptist Church and others. The dinners are provided free to those who wish to come & partake of them each Friday. Attendance has been up to 100 People.

Volunteers plan the meal, buy the food, prepare the meal, serve the meal – and do the after dinner clean up at Wellington Square. BBC has a committed group of 25 volunteers at present. They volunteer their time to assist the Wellington Square teams in presenting these Community Dinners.

In addition, in order to assist in keeping the dinners going through the summer season, BBC has committed, via its volunteer group, to actually be the full team of 12 to 14 people – with the guidance of a Co-ordinator from Wellington Square.

Port Nelson United have made a similar commitment to prepare and present a meal at Wellington Square.

The out of pocket costs for the dinners is borne by the group of institutions involved and by any on the spot donations received from those attending the dinners.

For instance, BBC paid the costs for the one Friday's food and supplies with the funds coming from Benevolent Donations.
