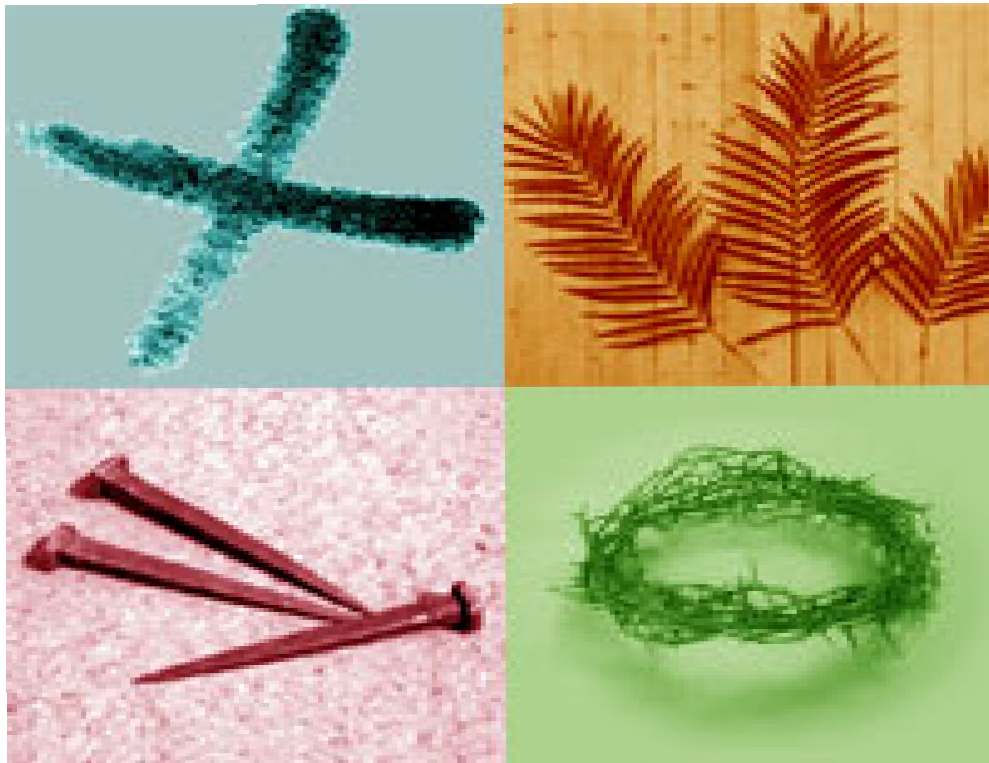

Explains how calendars were invented, how people kept track of time before clocks were used, what time is, and more.

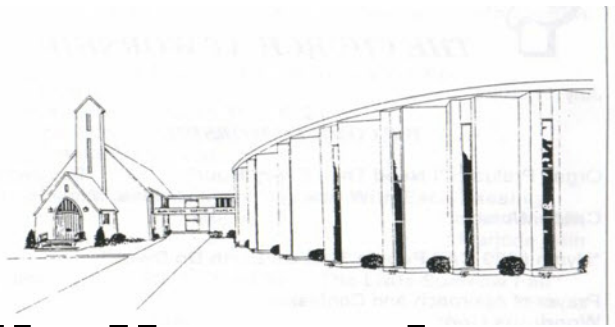
